#### What Makes Us Special

- Cub Clubs are offered both semesters. Cub Clubs allow students to self select enrichment activities that focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts/Athletics and Math.
- Students have the opportunity to participate in Art, Chorus, Recycle and Run clubs. In addition to these clubs, intermediate students can sign up for News Crew, Safety Patrols and Student Council.
- Students experience real-world problem solving through our MakerSpace and enrichment programs. Stop by and see our student butterfly garden and organic vegetable garden.

### Technology and the Future



- Students are introduced to new technologies and activities designed to build their problem solving, logical thinking, and collaboration skills.
- Students are exposed to coding and the CS2020 skills through lessons in the MakerSpace and real world projects in the garden.
- Computer Science 2020 Our students participate in at least 10 hours of computer science learning each school year.

#### Student Achievement 2021-2022 Data

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady
  progress monitoring. 64% of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and 66% of K5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **59%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.
